All participants develop a portfolio which serves as the "thesis" capstone project. All participants apply the National Board standards and exercises as they investigate their instructional performance and assess student learning. If desired and eligible, participants **choose** to apply for full NBPTS candidacy or *Take One!* which parallels the degree program and NBC timelines. National Board Certified Teachers (NBCTs) serve as instructors and trained support providers.
