Join an **online cohort** to earn a unique and valuable Master's Degree for TEACHERS who LEAD: **Master of Arts in Teaching with National Board Certification Leadership.**

Get familiar with **National Board Certification**. Explore and apply the **National Board Standards**. Examine your practice through reflection, analysis, and description of job embedded **work with your own students**.

This degree builds in options that “fit” your needs and goals:

- *I want to understand and learn about **National standards and certification**, but I don't want to pay for, or become a candidate at this time.*
- *I need a master's, AND I want to take advantage of developing the NBCT portfolio simultaneously as an active candidate.*
- *I want to distinguish myself as a teacher who wants to prepare for National Board in the future through this accelerated program that builds my competency and pedagogy with a National Board Leadership foundation.*
- *I have achieved NBCT, but need to renew or want to sharpen my skills.*

Explore, prepare for, and/or be an active NBCT candidate while you engage in and complete ten courses between **November, 2011 and September, 2012**. The schedule and coursework will uniquely parallel the NBCT submission timelines. Each of the five courses support the development of NBCT portfolio entries and culminates in March with your completed “thesis” project—your NBC Leadership Portfolio.

DEADLINE for the NOVEMBER start is OCTOBER 17.

- No GRE: Portfolio vs. Thesis
- Financial Aid available
- Develop the National Board Portfolio (your thesis) during NBC classes
- Option available to submit your portfolio to the NPBTS for scoring to earn national certification
- Current tuition is \$1,620 per course
